Michael has communicated his concerns to CAA about the proposal to implement the medical module of EMPIC. It is woefully lacking in any capability to assist Medical Examiners making pilot risk assessments. It has no functionality to classify medical issues in applicants or interrogate any useful medical data. It is not cloud based (requires client software to be installed). CAA are considering their next steps. Watching brief for now. Society position statement to be developed once CAA clarify their intended course of action.
